

Extended Learning Department: After School Credit Recovery Program Fall/Winter 2020

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the After School Credit Recovery Program?

The After School Credit Recovery Program is a program offered after the regular instructional day for high school students to recover credits. The focus of the fall and winter 2020 After School Credit Recovery Program is to provide high school students with the opportunity to continue their progress towards the completion of unfinished coursework in Edgenuity that began during distance learning in Summer 2020. All course offerings/sections will be offered through the Edgenuity program.

What are the dates of the After School Credit Recovery Program?

Specific dates and times of each class in the After School Credit Recovery Program may vary by each high school site; however, After School Credit Recovery classes for Fall 2020 are to begin on or after September 14, 2020 and will end on November 20, 2020.

What happens if a student does not complete the course by November 20, 2020 when the program ends?

Students who do not complete coursework by November 20, 2020 will be enrolled in the winter session of the After School Credit Recovery Program. Dates and hours of the winter session of the After School Credit Recovery Program has not been determined yet.

What is Edgenuity?

Edgenuity is an online program that provides standards-aligned curriculum for high school students to complete required coursework to meet graduation and/or A-G requirements. Edgenuity is the online program that was offered to all high school students through distance learning in Summer 2020.

Does the course need to cover semester 1 content if it is taken during the fall/winter session of the After School Credit Recovery Program?

No. Courses can be recovered/repeated out of sequence in the After School Credit Recovery Program. For example, a student can recover/repeat the 2nd semester of Algebra I during the fall/winter session of the After School Credit Recovery Program.

Who are the staff in the After School Credit Recovery Program?

Content specific credentialed teachers are staffed to teach in the After School Credit Recovery Program. For example, a math credentialed teacher will be teaching Algebra I in the After School Credit Recovery Program.

How do I enroll my student in the After School Credit Recovery Program?

Your student's high school counselor will enroll your student in the After School Credit Recovery Program as applicable. You may also reach out to your student's high school counselor to inquire or you may contact the Extended Learning Department at (559) 248-7560 or afterschool@fresnounified.org

How do I know if my student is enrolled in a class through the After School Credit Recovery Program?

The After School Credit Recovery course will show up on your student's class schedule in ATLAS as Period 11. You may also contact your student's high school counselor.
